Our website

OncoAct.nl (the **Website**) is a website controlled by Hartwig Medical Foundation. Hartwig Medical Foundation uses cookies to improve the use of the Website. If you use our Website, third parties (such as Google) may also place cookies on your computer, telephone or other device with which you visit the Website.

What are cookies?

A cookie is a small text file that is stored on your computer, telephone or other device that you use to visit the Website, allowing the Website to remember who you are and/or what your preferred language is for the Website. For more information about cookies, please also refer to:

Purposes of the use of cookies

The Website uses cookies for the following purposes:

- Functional purposes: to provide the visitor with a functioning Website;
- Analytical purposes: to collect and analyze information about the use of the Website, the number of visitors of the Website and the sources of traffic to the Website (*i.e.* how visitors have been (re)directed to the Website) and to improve the functioning of the Website based on the collected and analyzed information.

For these analytical purposes Hartwig Medical Foundation makes use of Google Analytics, in accordance with the guidelines as published by the Dutch Data Protection Authority on 27 August 2018 available on its website (link: [here](#)).

Google Analytics provides a web-analysis service through cookies that analyze how the Website is used by visitors. The data which is generated by the cookies (in the case of our Website, without (entire) IP address) shall be transferred and saved by Google on servers that are located in the United States. Google uses this information to monitor how you use the Website as well as to offer other us services relating to the activity of the Website and the use of internet. Google may only transfer this information to third parties if it has a legal requirement to do so, or if the data is being processed on Google's behalf by such parties. Hartwig Medical Foundation has entered into a data processing agreement with Google for the use of Google Analytics. We do not make use of any other services provided by Google.

Under these conditions, the use of Google Analytics is deemed to have a very limited impact on the rights and freedoms of visitors the Website and therefore may be used without obtaining the Website user's prior consent.

How do you manage / delete these cookies?

You can disable the use of Google Analytics through the opt-out function or in your browser settings.

All major internet browsers offer the possibility to manage the cookies that are installed on your computer or mobile device. You will be able to consent to the use and placement of (third party) cookies, unless the cookies are essential for the Website to work properly or serve to provide you with a better, faster and safer user experience. For these cookies no consent is required.

We note that when you disable certain cookies that we use, there is a possibility that certain parts of our Website may not function properly and you will no longer enjoy an optimal user experience.

We are in no way responsible or liable for the processing of personal data by Google. Google is individually responsible for the data processing conducted by them and has its own separate and independent privacy policy.
